# Parties, Alcohol, and Conduct

Your club's name should not appear on any flyers to parties and should not mention FSU.

- If a party you throw can be traced back to an FSU Sports Club, that Sports Club will face disciplinary actions
- This includes putting just the sport you compete in, and having an FSU location on the flyer (this can be traced back)
- For example: Your flyer should not say FSU Club Underwater Basketweaving Party OR Underwater Basketweaving Party

Club Member's should not be seen at clubs, bars, or social events involving alcohol or drugs wearing their club attire

Remember that when wearing a uniform or club gear you are representing your Sport Club and FSU and should act accordingly



# SCEC Nominations:

## **All SCEC Members**

- Attend required meetings and represent all sport clubs
- Make budgeting, tier placement, and conduct decisions
- Communicate policies, deadlines, and updates to clubs

## **Chair**

- Lead and preside over all meetings
- Represent the council in official matters
- Direct budget proposals to SGA

## **Vice Chair**

- Act in place of the Chair when needed
- Oversee meeting records and allocation processes

## **Treasurer**

- Manage and monitor sport club funding
- Oversee allocations and national fund requests
- Present financial proposals to SGA

## **Secretary**

- Organize meetings, agendas, and minutes
- Maintain records, documents, and voting results
- Coordinate elections and board communications

## **Recruitment Chair**

- Promote the sport club program and member clubs
- Lead Recruitment Nights and marketing efforts
- Track membership numbers and updates



# SCEC Nominations:

## **SCEC Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be a member of an active Sport Club Council organization
- Must be a full-time FSU student in good academic and disciplinary standing
- Must be able to serve a full academic year (returning fall and enrolled in spring)
- Only one member per club may serve on the Executive Board





# Budget Presentations/Week:

**ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY!**

**April 6-9th- exact times and location TBD**

- Fill out 2026 -2027 Annual Budget Request
  - This is a request so ask for as much as you think your club will need
- 15-minute PowerPoint presentation to present to the SCEC including the following information:
  - General Information about your club
    - Number of members
    - Achievements of the team during the year
  - Practices/tournaments
    - How frequent practices are and where
    - Clubs' participation in competitions including ones hosted and traveled to
  - Fundraising/community service
  - Dues
  - Expenses
  - Revenue
  - Budget Request and why!
- After budget week you will receive an email with your allocated amount and updated tier.

# Nationals/Post-Season Travel Fund

- This is a chance for clubs traveling to Nationals or Post-Season events for their club sport representing FSU to receive extra funding.
  - This is separate from your allocated budget!
- Must submit the "**Post Season Travel Budget Request Form**" in Nole Central at least 14 days in advance, just like regular funded travels.
  - Exceptions can be made here if you do not qualify before the 2-week deadline.
- SCEC will determine levels of funding they can provide these travels.
- You do not need to submit a regular Travel Request Form if you have submitted this for your travel.



# Allocated Funds

- 50% OF ALLOCATED FUNDS MUST BE SPENT BY FEBRUARY 26TH
  - Emails have been sent out if you have not reached this threshold.
- 100% of allocated funds must be spent or accounted for by March 26th
  - This is a hard deadline. All remaining funds will be swept on March 27th.
    - Money is permitted to be spent after March 26th for post March needs, however you must email Zoe with details of exactly where your funds are going and when before March 26th!
- For items like equipment, you must request these purchases before March 26th. Only requests that include deadlines after March 26th (funded trips, flights, etc.) will be accepted.
- Please DO NOT leave it until March 26th to request purchases. If possible, please send Zoe a email with your request 14 days prior to needing the items.
  - Zoe can only purchase so much each day. Once that limit is reached Zoe has to wait until the following day to make another purchase.

# Reminders:

- Travel:
- TRFs must be submitted at least 14 days in advance of departure for all funded travels
  - Non-funded travels will remain at 8 days in advance
  - NO SUBMITTING BLANK ROSTERS!
  - Everything needs to be approved, and binders picked up 3 days prior to departure
- Practice Attendance:
  - Check-ins will be on DSE, and any officer will need to go into their scheduled practice and check off who is in attendance. All practices for the spring semester are on DSE and accessible for all officers.
- Practice Cancellations:
  - Practice Cancellation forms must be submitted at least 24 hours before your canceled practice, or you will lose tomahawk points. In case of an emergency or unforeseen circumstance please let Zoe and your supervisor know asap!
- GBM Attendance:
  - If later than 5 minutes to GBM's you will not receive points for attending. Your 4 core officers should all be present. Additional club members are welcome to attend but cannot come in place of an officer.



# Reminders:

- Branding:
  - Once your new uniforms have arrived, you must wear these uniforms while representing FSU Sport Clubs.
  - All Branding must still go through Zoe or Brandon.
- Reimbursement Checks:
  - If you receive an email notifying you that there is a check for you to pick up, please do so ASAP.
  - These checks expire, so if you do not pick them up quickly, they will have to be recut, and you will wait longer to be reimbursed.
  - After a reimbursement is pending under your name you must sign the DocuSign sent to your email by Denise Atkinson to continue the reimbursement process!
