Nationals/Post-Season Travel Fund

- This is a chance for clubs traveling to Nationals or Post-Season events for their club sport representing FSU to receive extra funding.
 - This is separate from your allocated budget!
- Must submit the "**Post Season Travel Budget Request Form**" in Nole Central at least 14 days in advance, just like regular funded travels.
 - Exceptions can be made here if you do not qualify before the 2-week deadline.
- SCEC will determine levels of funding they can provide these travels.
- You do not need to submit a regular Travel Request Form if you have submitted this for your travel.
- We cannot fund charter buses unless absolutely necessary!!



Nationals/Post-Season Travel Fund

- Scan this QR code to let us know if you will be submitting a request for the Nationals/Post-Season Travel Fund. Clubs who answer yes before March 27th will be prioritized. Only one member from each club needs to fill out this survey.





E-Board Elections

- Need to have taken place before April 20th.


