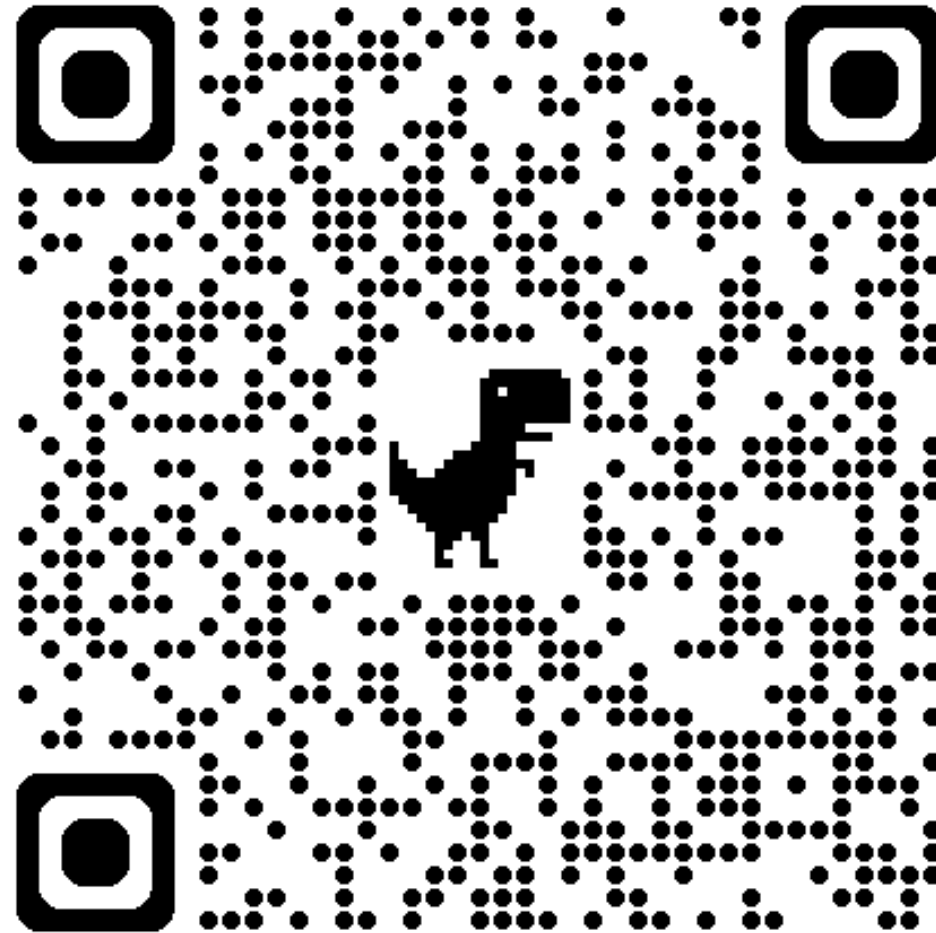

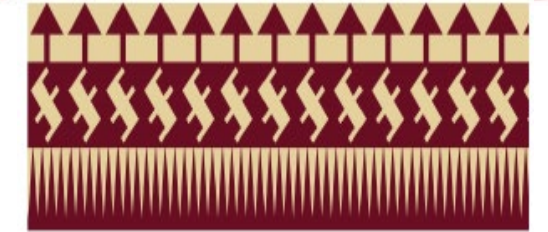

REMINDERS



- All current Florida State University students, except for students classified as FSU Next, who are enrolled in at least one Main Campus class can play
- Faculty and staff, and alumni are not eligible for participation in the Sport Club Program unless associated with a club as an advisor, coach, or volunteer.
- Anyone who meets the above requirements are allowed to be a part of sports clubs and payment is not required by them to be on the team.
- Dues are only to be charged if the member is receiving something for their payment
- Always look in handbook for clarification of who can and can't participate
- Make sure all coaches fill out the coaching agreement form!
 - Maximum 4 coaches per club
- Please review your constitutions!!!! You have until October 16th to make changes and send to the office for review

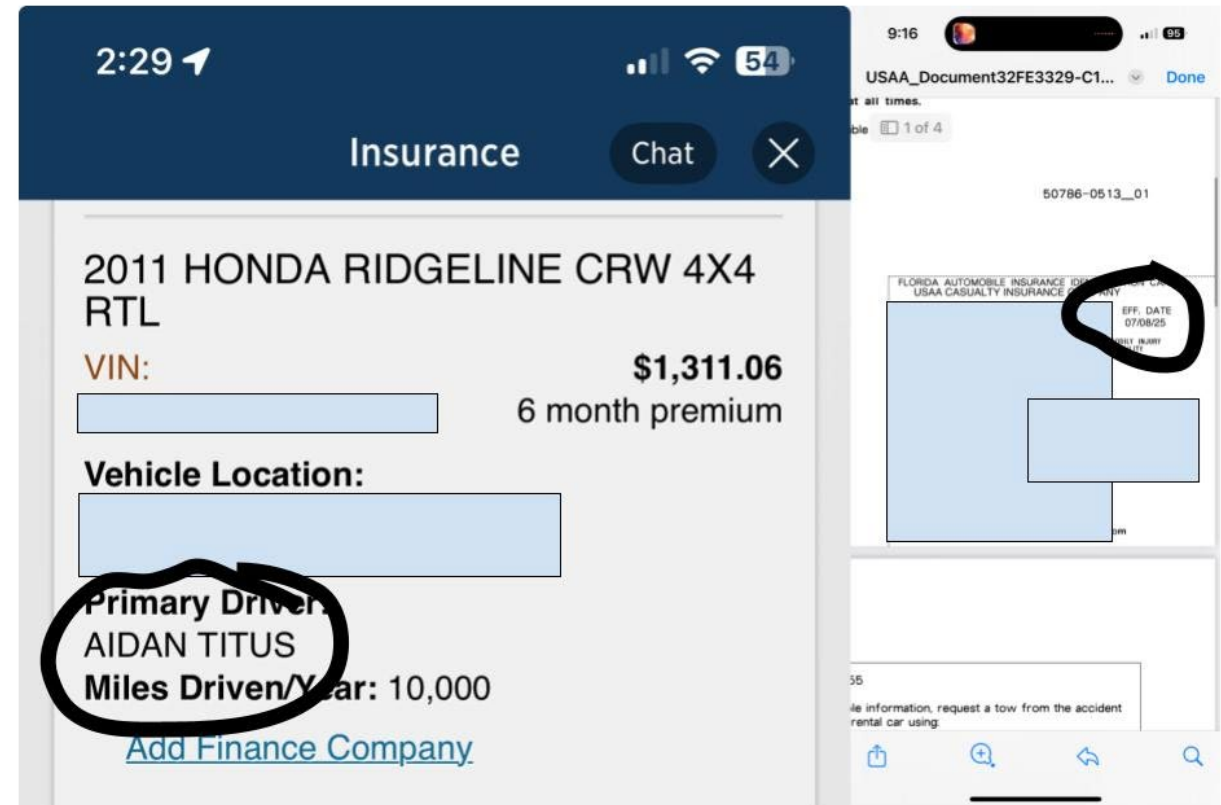
DSE Auto Insurance -

- Must have CLUB MEMBERS NAME on submission
 - Call insurance company, look at policy (most likely listed as a dependent), wallet insurance card. Can be found on the declaration page of insurance policy!!
- Must have a clear start and end date
- Must be submitted once expired

Accepted submissions include: wallet card, insurance policy, digital insurance card uploaded to DSE

NO health insurance or vehicle registration!

If you're not planning to drive you do not need to upload your insurance or license!

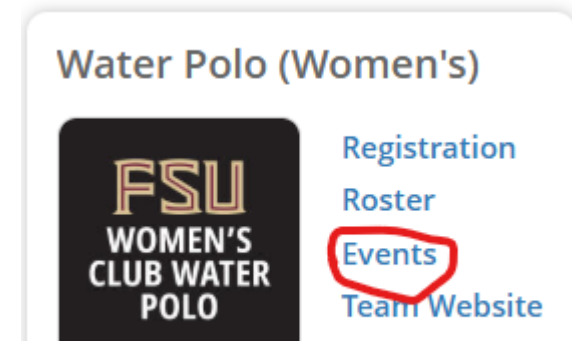


Practice Attendance - DSE

Travel Reminders



- Clubs MUST submit their Travel Request Forms at least 14 days before a funded travel, and 8 days before an unfunded travel
 - If submitted less than 8 days before the travel, it will be denied
- Please submit TRFs as soon as possible
 - Rosters can be changed afterwards, even after the travel is approved
 - Rosters must be returned fully updated, and signed by everyone
- You only sign the check-in/out form when you return the binder to the MCF office
- We like to have a seatbelt for all riders so roughly 5 people per car (unless larger vehicle is clarified in the application process!)
- All payments from Sport Clubs should be reimbursements! We will only pay directly for travel expenses due to extenuating circumstances.



Travel Request Form Reminders

- Binders need to be picked up by 5:00 PM three days before you leave town.
- Binders must be returned within three school days of your return to town.
- **Common Mistakes:**
 - Travel Roster is not fully on DSE. All players participating must be registered through DSE
 - Drivers are not approved drivers. All drivers must be approved as drivers on DSE.

If they are not approved, there is a note stating the corrections that need to be made.
 - Not checking FSUHQ and your submission after you submit! We make comments on what needs to be fixed before we can approve your travel.

FSUHQ - Where are the forms?

- Purchase Forms: Can be found under the documents tab – Budget
- Sports Clubs handbook: found under the document tab – Officer Resources
- Injury Reports + Visiting Team Waiver (for home events): found under the documents tab – Risk Management
- If there are problems with any forms that are submitted, you can find feedback under your submission

- For example, the garnet tier minimums add up to 370 points, but your club needs at least 400 total points to reach the garnet tier.

Tomahawk Point Deductions



- Clubs can get points deducted by both the Sport Club Office and the SCEC
- Clubs will be allowed one minor offense as a warning before having points deducted
- **You can lose points for the following:**
 - Not submitting a practice cancellation form when your club will not be practicing
 - Missing or showing up late/leaving early from a GBM without pre approval
 - Submitting travel forms late, collecting/returning binder late
 - Missing deadlines
 - No practice check ins
 - Members practicing who have not signed the DSE waiver

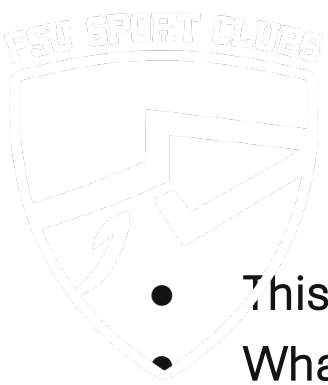

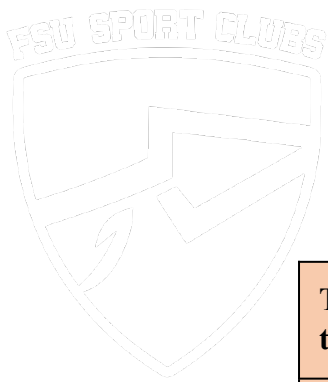




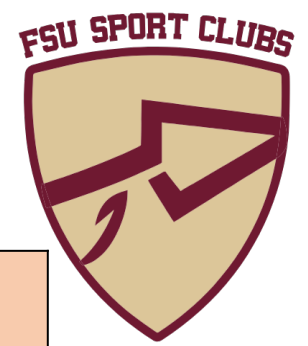
Halloween Spooktacular



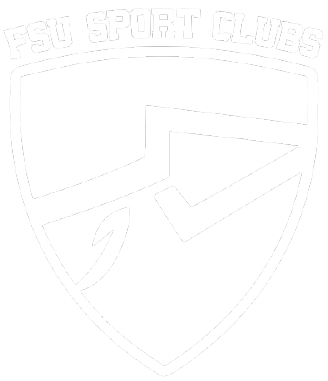
- This event will take place October 30th from 5:00 PM- 9:00 PM at Cascades Park
